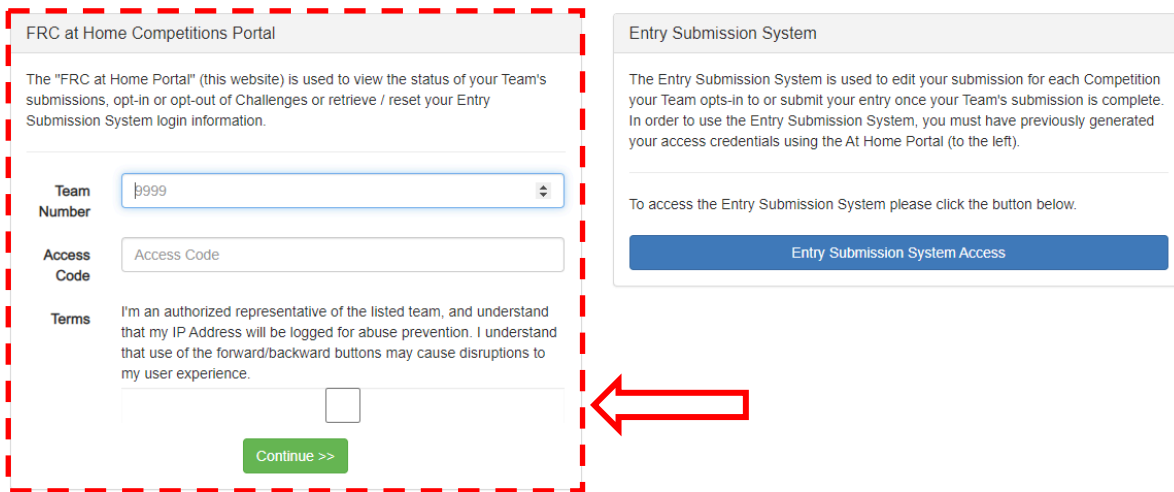


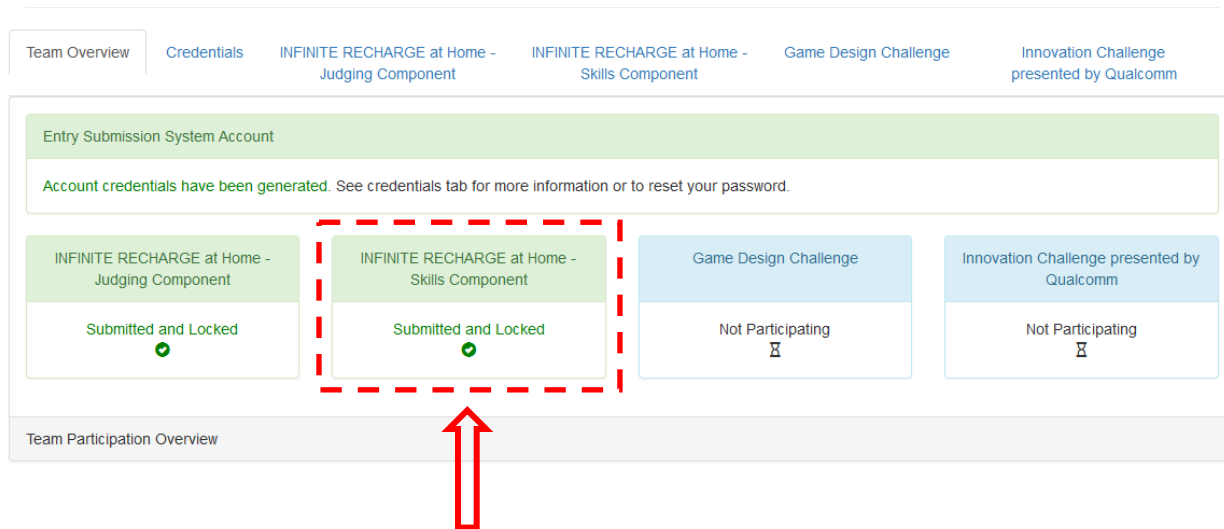
2021 FIRST® Robotics Competition At Home Challenges – Good To Go Guide

This Good To Go Guide is intended to provide a visual guide for teams to know if they are submitted and ready to be ranked in their group for the Skills Competition and any awards for which they are eligible.

To start, go to frcathome.org and enter your access credentials you used previously to Opt-In and Submit for other challenges. For more information on how to access this site, refer to the [Quick Start Guide](#) or the [Unofficial Participant Guide](#).



Upon logging in, the box titled “INFINITE RECHARGE® At Home – Skills Component” should be Green and contain the status text of “Submitted and Locked”. If you are part of the Samarium Group, this box also contains “Unofficial Participant”. If you see this, you are Good To Go!



If you do not see the status as described above, you have not Submitted and Locked your entry for the Skills Component and will not be considered for winning Skills awards. If it is before the April 8th deadline, you can

still open your entry, enter all the necessary information, and submit it. For more detailed information on submitting entries, refer to the [Quick Start Guide](#) or the [Unofficial Participant Guide](#).

REMINDER! Depending on video length and your Internet connection speed, it may take several minutes to upload your file. An entry cannot be Submitted and Locked while the upload is processing. Make sure to upload videos with enough time for it to complete so you can click the “Submit and Lock” button before the April 8th deadline. Just as with all other deadlines in FRC (or anywhere!), you should plan to be early to help ensure you are not late!

Check the status of your scores before submitting! Status information may take a few minutes to update once scores are entered in the Entry Submission System. If you are unsure if your scores are valid please wait for the status to be updated in the FRC At Home Portal and verify your entry is compliant with the rules. To check the validity of the scores, log in to the FRC At Home Portal, click on the “INFINITE RECHARGE At Home – Skills Component” tab and look for the rows labeled for each Skills Challenge. If they are all green with a check mark, you are Good To Go! If not, you either have not entered the score, the score was received but the status has not been updated yet, or the entered score is invalid.

INFINITE RECHARGE at Home includes a Skills Competition consisting of five challenges, inspired by INFINITE RECHARGE. Teams may opt to compete in as many or as few of the challenges as they would like. Teams should try to complete at least three (3) of the challenges. For a Skills Competition entry to be valid for awards consideration, a complete submission in the Judged component is required.

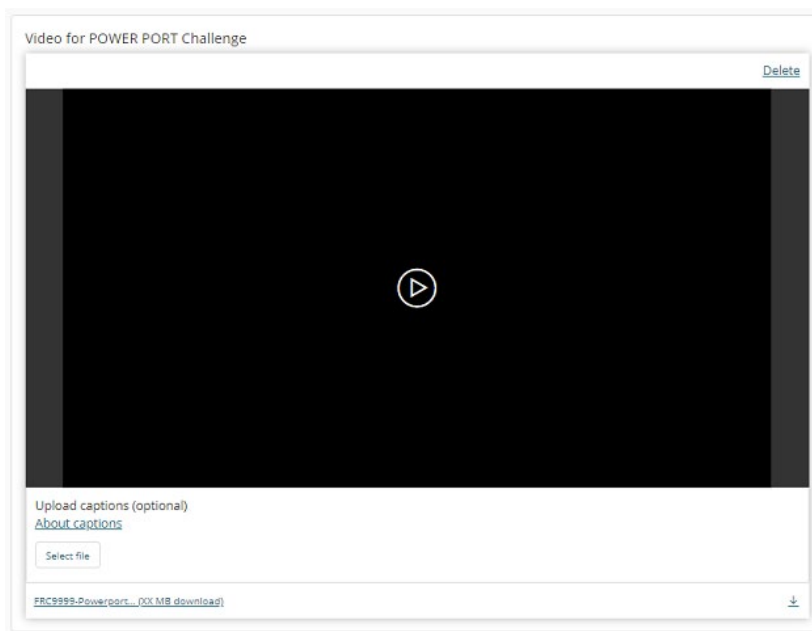

Please note the below information is based only on your entries, scores and uploaded videos are subject to review by FIRST HQ. Scores are only counted when a corresponding video is present. Note that there may be a short delay between scores and videos bring entered in the Entry Submission System and being reflected in the below information.

If you have invalid scores, an alert message is displayed in a yellow box near the top of the Skills tab. This lists all scores that are detected as invalid based on the rules in the [2021 At Home Challenges Manual](#). Refer to the sections for scoring each challenge, starting with Section 2.4.6 Galactic Search Challenge. If you receive the red alert on the Skills tab (as pictured above), we have reviewed your videos and modified them based on the scores clearly represented in the video, per Section 2.2.1 Additional Requirements for the Skills Competition.

Within the Entry Submission System you can check that your video uploaded successfully by making sure it is playable. After a successful upload and transcode, you should see an embedded video player as shown in the below photo. If you do not see the embedded player after your video is finished, it may be in an unsupported format. Try converting to another format (a free tool such as [Handbrake](#) can be used to do this) and uploading again. The upload and transcode process can take a few minutes, or more, depending on your internet connection.
