General

- Last One: Team Update 21 is the final Team Update of the 2018 FIRST POWER UP season.
- Auto Plate Assignment: As noted in Q405, one pattern in the four possible patterns of switch/scale randomization appeared more frequently than desired. We have now implemented a solution that results in more uniform distribution of plate patterns, and this solution was deployed during Week 6 events.

The answer to Q405 has been updated as follows:

Updated: 4/10/18

The plates are randomized into one of four patterns, there is no consideration or compensation to guarantee that any individual pattern will appear an equal number of times. However, we too have noticed the RLR pattern appearing more frequently over the thousands of matches that have already been played this season, and we are looking into it.

As announced in Team Update 21, as of week 6 events, a patch has been deployed that results in more uniform PLATE pattern distribution.

- qualifying award winners among district teams who traveled to Regionals,
- teams on the final District ranking list, as deep in the ranking list as the District needs to go to fill their allocation.


Section 10.12.3.9 District Championships with Multiple Divisions


Some District Championships will have multiple divisions. In these cases:


 Division winning ALLIANCES play each other in District Championship Playoffs, employing the bracket below that corresponds to their District, until a winning ALLIANCE for the event is determined.











- Teams participating in District Championship Playoffs earn Playoff round performance District points as described in Section 10.12.3.3.
- If an ALLIANCE in a District Championship Playoff has not yet adopted a BACKUP ROBOT per Section 10.5.2, the ALLIANCE CAPTAIN may bring in only the highest seeded team from their Division's pool of available teams to join its ALLIANCE.
- Team assignments to the Divisions are determined using an algorithm developed by *FIRST* in Michigan to balance Divisions with respect to team strengths.
